

EFC 134 OFFICIAL WEIGH-IN COMPLETE AS ATHLETES PREPARE FOR GLOBAL SHOWCASE



Johannesburg, South Africa – 3 June 2026

The official weigh-in for EFC 134 is complete, with athletes making their final preparations ahead of Thursday night's event at the World Sports Betting EFC Arena in Johannesburg.

Throughout the morning, athletes from across South Africa, Nigeria, Namibia, Zimbabwe, and the Democratic Republic of Congo stepped onto the scales knowing that months of preparation had reached their final checkpoint.

With championship gold, title contention, and career-defining opportunities on the line, the atmosphere remained focused and composed as fighters completed the last formal requirement before entering the Hexagon.

As the weigh-in progressed, anticipation continued to build. Final face-offs brought opponents together one last time before fight night, with every athlete now fully aware that preparation is complete and only performance remains.

Nowhere was that more evident than in the main event.

Women's flyweight champion Amanda "Mad Dog" Lino successfully weighed in at 125 pounds ahead of her title defence against Nigeria's Juliet Chukwu, who came in at 124 pounds. The championship rivals looked composed and confident as they completed the final stage of fight week ahead of one of the most significant women's title fights in African MMA history.

The co-main event flyweight clash between Sisa Jungula and Thapelo Seabi was also officially confirmed, while athletes throughout the card completed their final preparations ahead of Thursday night's action.

Tomorrow night, competitors from across the continent will enter the Hexagon carrying ambition, expectation, and the opportunity to take a significant step forward in their careers. For some, it is about defending status. For others, it is about announcing themselves on one of the sport's biggest stages.

The event also marks the beginning of EFC's new global broadcast partnership with DAZN, making Africa's premier MMA organisation available to fans across more than 200 markets worldwide and significantly expanding the international reach of African MMA.
