

RISING AFRICAN TALENT SET TO IGNITE EFC 134 PRELIMS

PROSPECTS, FINISHERS, AND BREAKTHROUGH FIGHTS
READY FOR JUNE 4 IN JOHANNESBURG



Johannesburg, South Africa – 27 May 2026

With just over a week remaining until EFC 134, the event's preliminary card is set to showcase some of the most dangerous emerging talent currently rising through African MMA when the action begins live on Discover Sport on June 4.

Representing multiple countries, gyms, and fighting backgrounds from across the continent, the EFC 134 preliminaries combine explosive newcomers, aggressive finishers, respected prospects, and athletes searching for career defining performances inside the Hexagon.

Among the featured matchups, Jason "Tension" Mackay returns after making a major impression early in his EFC career. Training under Don Madge at Madfit MMA in South Africa, Mackay faces Democratic Republic of Congo athlete Guelor "King" Sondi, a durable and unpredictable opponent known for creating chaos inside fights.

Bantamweight action sees Namibia's Veja Hinda continue his rise inside the EFC Hexagon when he faces Durban based Silverback MMA athlete Bheki "Dog Danger" Ngcobo. Hinda impressed during his EFC debut and now faces an aggressive striker carrying speed, finishing intent, and hometown ambition into the matchup.

Welterweight action features Alex Suzuki against Glody Kanzeko in a clash of contrasting styles. Suzuki continues developing his reputation around explosive wrestling and physical takedowns, while Kanzeko moves up a division searching for success through aggressive stand up exchanges and nonstop pressure.

Also featured on the preliminary card, Bruce "MANZAKA" Mayasi faces Andile "The Equalizer" Gasa in a matchup expected to produce heavy striking exchanges between two athletes who thrive in aggressive fights. Mayasi represents Fight City Gym under former champion Demarte Pena, while Gasa enters carrying experience and confidence in stand up battles.

Featherweight prospects Alex Kapinga and Nasiphi Vellum also collide in an important matchup between two athletes looking to establish themselves deeper within the division. Kapinga has

already proven his durability inside the Hexagon, while Vellum arrives carrying momentum and growing expectations around his future in EFC.

Opening the card, South Africa's Stefan Diedericks faces Zimbabwean boxer Themrani "Spanner Boy" Mhlanga in a matchup built around striking and pressure. Diedericks brings toughness and bareknuckle experience into the Hexagon while Mhlanga finally makes his long awaited EFC debut after injury previously delayed his arrival.

The EFC 134 preliminary card streams live globally on Discover Sport before the internationally televised main card begins.
