**Johannesburg, South Africa – 22 June 2026**

One of EFC's most promising middleweight prospects will face his toughest challenge to date when undefeated Durban athlete Adei Volker takes on returning veteran Armand Scheepers at EFC 136 on August 6.

Representing Forge MMA under coach William Olberholzer, Volker has quickly established himself as a rising contender in the middleweight division. The 27-year-old carries a perfect 2-0 EFC record and is coming off a dominant victory over Wallace Okasso in his most recent appearance.

Volker's grappling credentials have already attracted attention inside the Hexagon. Groomed specifically for mixed martial arts competition and backed by a strong Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu background, he has showcased heavy top control and a relentless submission game throughout his professional career.

While his ground game has proven highly effective, his striking remains largely untested at EFC level, leaving questions about how he will respond when faced with a more experienced and well-rounded opponent.

That challenge arrives in the form of Scheepers.

The South African veteran returns to EFC competition for the first time since EFC 75, where he faced Joe Cummins. Despite the lengthy absence, Scheepers brings valuable experience to the matchup along with a reputation for durability and an aggressive fighting style.

Training under South African MMA pioneer Rico Hattingh, Scheepers also possesses a high-level Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu game of his own, creating an intriguing dynamic between two athletes who are comfortable both on the feet and on the ground.

For Volker, the bout represents an opportunity to continue his climb through the middleweight ranks and prove he belongs among the division's emerging contenders.

For Scheepers, it marks the start of a comeback campaign against one of the division's fastest-rising prospects.

The matchup adds another compelling middleweight contest to an EFC 136 card headlined by interim lightweight champion Adrian Sanchez and Bradley Swanepoel.

The announcement comes ahead of EFC 135, where bantamweight champion Faez Jacobs is scheduled to defend his title against Gift Walker before attention shifts to EFC 136 on August 6.

This bout features on the EFC 136 main card, presented by World Sports Betting live from the World Sports Betting EFC Arena in Johannesburg, South Africa on August 6.
