

EFC 134 TELEVISED MAIN CARD CONFIRMED

LINO VS CHUKWU HEADLINES MAJOR NIGHT OF ACTION ON JUNE 4 IN JOHANNESBURG

The televised main card for EFC 134 has now been confirmed ahead of the event taking place on June 4 at the World Sports Betting EFC Arena in Johannesburg, South Africa.

With championship gold, rising contenders, respected veterans, and dangerous finishers spread throughout the lineup, EFC 134 continues building into one of the promotion's strongest and most complete broadcast cards of the year.

Headlining the event, reigning women's flyweight champion Amanda "Mad Dog" Lino defends her title against Nigeria's Juliet Chukwu in one of the biggest women's bouts in African MMA history.

Lino remains one of the most accomplished athletes ever produced by EFC, having previously captured championship gold across two divisions while competing against elite opposition throughout her career. Standing opposite her is reigning EFC bantamweight champion Juliet Chukwu, who now attempts to become a two division champion and further cement herself as one of the fastest rising names in African MMA.

The co-main event sees Sisa Jungula face Thapelo "The Phenomenal One" Seabi in a flyweight clash carrying major implications beneath current champion Tumelo Manyamala.

Representing PE Submission Fighting Academy under Chris Bright, Jungula continues building momentum through composed and disciplined performances inside the Hexagon. Seabi enters

representing Smiley Academy in Polokwane under reigning EFC featherweight champion Igue Kabesa, with both athletes viewing EFC 134 as a potential breakthrough moment within the division.

Elsewhere on the televised card, respected veteran Vince Bembe meets rising lightweight Khanyo Maqam in a classic experience versus ambition matchup. Fighting out of Dominators Den under Cedric Doyle, Bembe has spent years competing against elite opposition across multiple divisions. Maqam now steps into the biggest opportunity of his young professional career after building strong expectations around his future.

Bantamweight action follows as Godfrey “Feralspunk” Mkhwanazi faces William “Ragnar” Lekana in a dangerous striking matchup between two athletes known for aggression and finishing intent. Mkhwanazi represents Godfather MMA under Ferdie Basson, while Lekana arrives following a major knockout victory in his previous appearance.

Opening the televised main card, Tebatso “The Glory of Torture” Molele takes on Zimbabwe’s Lecture “The Mafia” Gumbi in a flyweight contest expected to produce nonstop pressure and violent exchanges from the opening bell. Molele enters representing Mamelodi Warriors under coach Moses Manaka, while Gumbi fights out of TopGun MMA in Zimbabwe carrying heavy handed boxing and a reputation for thriving in close range battles.

The confirmed televised card combines championship experience, emerging contenders, regional rivalries, and proven finishers across multiple divisions ahead of a global broadcast reaching audiences throughout Africa and internationally.

The EFC 134 preliminary card streams live globally on Discover Sport ahead of the main card broadcast on SuperSport, SABC Openview, Discover Sport, and EFC broadcast partners worldwide.
