

EFC 132: KEY MATCHUPS TAKE SHAPE AS FIGHT NIGHT APPROACHES

Johannesburg, South Africa — With just two weeks remaining, EFC 132 is entering its final phase as key matchups across the card begin to take focus ahead of fight night.

A new episode of EFC Engaged has been released, offering a closer look at the main event and selected bouts as the athletes prepare for April 9 in Johannesburg.

Headlining the event is a heavyweight championship clash between DRC’s Matunga “HHH” Djikasa and Senegal’s Adama Diop.

Djikasa returns to defend his title with a striking style built on range and control, while Diop enters the bout undefeated in EFC, bringing a powerful wrestling base and a direct, physical approach into the matchup.

Beyond the main event, several fights on the card are beginning to draw attention.

In the middleweight division, JT Botha meets Mzwandile Hlongwa in a contest between two experienced fighters with contrasting approaches, as Botha’s control and power face Hlongwa’s durability and striking output.

Former flyweight champion Gift Walker returns to action against Angola’s Eduardo Barros, a matchup that brings experience, composure, and technical striking into focus.

Elsewhere on the card, a number of emerging and returning athletes continue their preparations, with bouts across the bantamweight, welterweight, flyweight, and featherweight divisions adding depth to the lineup.

With the event approaching and final preparations underway, EFC 132 is set to deliver a complete night of fights leading into a heavyweight championship main event.

EFC 132 takes place April 9 in Johannesburg and is presented by World Sports Betting.
