EFC 130 FULL FIGHT CARD BREAKDWON

Johannesburg, South Africa - EFC closes out the biggest year in African MMA with a stacked thirteen fight card headlined by the opening round of the Flyweight Grand Prix. From rising contenders to veteran clashes, EFC 130 carries consequences for multiple divisions and promises an explosive final chapter to the 2025 season.

Below is the full fight by fight preview ahead of fight night.

MAIN EVENT FLYWEIGHT GRAND PRIX

Ntando Zondi vs Nathaniel Komana

A pivotal opening round of the Flyweight Grand Prix sees lethal finisher Ntando Zondi collide with the composed technical danger of Nathaniel Komana. Zondi enters unbeaten in his last six EFC appearances, carrying crisp striking, forward pressure and a reputation for momentum-shifting bursts of offense. Komana arrives in career best form after dropping to flyweight, where his counter timing, range control and patience have transformed him into a serious contender. This is a classic meeting of aggression and precision with the potential to define the entire tournament.

CO MAIN EVENT FLYWEIGHT GRAND PRIX

Tumelo Manyamala vs Lihle Ngamntwini

Tumelo 'Mellow' Manyamala returns from The Ultimate Fighter house ready to reclaim his path to championship gold. Known for accuracy, clean striking and calm execution, he enters the Grand Prix with high expectations. Across from him stands Lihle 'Rush Hour' Ngamntwini who brings five straight victories, relentless output and clever pace management. This matchup pits technical mastery against sustained pressure with a place in the semifinals on the line.

MAIN CARD

Zhane Tannous vs Conrad Seabi

Zhane Tannous has burst into the EFC with two first round finishes backed by explosive physicality and heavy top control. His athletic presence has made him one of the most intriguing new talents in the promotion. Veteran Conrad 'Cagewise' Seabi returns to the Hex with over a decade of experience, sharp boxing and the toughness that has defined his storied career. This meeting of rising prospect versus battle hardened veteran carries major implications for both athletes.

Peace Nguphane vs Armando De Crescenzo

Peace Nguphane was on the verge of a welterweight title fight before injury delayed the championship picture. Rather than wait on the sidelines he chose to risk his ranking and stay active. He now meets the undefeated Muay Thai specialist Armando De Crescenzo who brings knockout power, creativity and the confidence of an athlete who has never tasted defeat. This is a compelling matchup between a proven contender and a dangerous newcomer looking to make his breakthrough.

Eduardo Barros vs Bryn Gwavava

Angolan veteran Eduardo Barros returns with refined striking, smart movement and experience against some of the division's best. Opposing him is unbeaten Zimbabwean finisher Bryn 'Soul Proprietor' Gwavava who has ended both of his EFC fights in the first round. This meeting blends experience with rising momentum and will clarify who moves toward the bantamweight contender ranks.

PRELIMS

Chadrack Yemba vs Roberto Miyaba

Unbeaten striker Chadrack Yemba brings long range technicality, sharp angles and a calm fight tempo. Roberto 'Rapid Fire' Miyaba brings blistering speed, explosive kicks and an evolving submission threat that surprised many in his last outing. Their styles collide in a matchup made for action and could produce one of the most entertaining fights on the card.

Bradley Swanepoel vs Sizwe Mnikathi

Bradley 'The Nightmare' Swanepoel returns after time away looking sharper than ever with his dangerous grappling and strong finishing instinct. He faces Sizwe Mnikathi whose twenty four fight career has made him one of the most durable veterans in the promotion. This is a crossroads bout between a rising athlete and a proven expert at dragging opponents into deep waters.

Brandon Santos vs Godknows Ndlovu

Brandon 'Little Beast' Santos brings crisp boxing, strong fundamentals and the poise of a rising star. Across from him stands the relentlessly tough Godknows Ndlovu whose pressure and physicality test every opponent he faces. This matchup of precision versus pressure is built to reveal who is ready for the next tier.

Mpho Hloka vs David Mambo

Mpho Hloka mixes creative scrambles, sharp submissions and confident striking developed under Boyd Allen's guidance. David Mambo brings forward pressure, power and the kind of heavy shots that force opponents to react. Two aggressive styles meet in a fight that should produce consistent action.

Ash Zola vs Liam Schultz

Ash Zola returns with unorthodox striking and proven durability. Debutant Liam Schultz arrives with strong wrestling, top control and high level preparation from the QuanWessels team. A classic striker versus grappler scenario sets the stage for a tense tactical battle.

Lucky Magekha vs Mlungisi Mbizane

Lucky Magekha carries his trademark aggression and forward marching kickboxing style into this bout. Mlungisi Mbizane, a five time national Shuriken champion, brings speed, power and knockout intent. This contest features two heavy hitters who rarely take a backward step.

Adei Volker vs Alex Suzuki

National champion Adei Volker makes his professional debut with years of amateur excellence behind him. Across the Hex stands Alex Suzuki whose explosive wrestling and athletic drive have made him a standout prospect. The two last met at Nationals and now revisit the rivalry on the biggest stage of their careers.

Lucky Bosco vs Itumeleng Mabilo

Lucky Bosco returns with raw strength, aggressive pressure and the ability to turn any exchange into a brawl. Opposite him is debutant Itumeleng Mabilo who brings technical balance and composure developed over a long amateur career. This matchup offers an early spotlight opportunity for both athletes.
