
MOYO MISSES WEIGHT, HHH STILL ELIGIBLE FOR HEAVYWEIGHT GOLD

OFFICIAL EFC 127 WEIGH-IN RESULTS

10 September 2025



Johannesburg, South Africa The drama of fight week reached a crescendo at today's official weigh-in for EFC 127, with a stunning twist in the heavyweight title picture.

Champion Elvis Moyo, son of Zimbabwe, former All-Africa boxing champion, and a cornerstone of African combat sports, was unable to make the 265 lbs heavyweight limit. After missing the ceremonial weigh-in earlier in the day, Moyo arrived later and officially weighed in at 267 lbs*, forcing him to relinquish his title.

Despite this, Moyo's decision to step forward and still face his challenger demonstrates his heart and commitment to the fans. His legendary career and willingness to fight on ensure his reputation remains untarnished — a champion in spirit, regardless of circumstance.

Opposite him, Matunga "HHH Power" Djikasa weighed in at a flawless 255 lbs, making him the only fighter eligible to win the heavyweight crown tomorrow night. For the son of the Congo, this is more than a fight — it is a chance to reclaim the

belt he once held and to etch his name once more into the history of African MMA. Djikasa now carries the weight of opportunity and legacy into the hexagon.

- Lightweight Showdown: Guelor Sondi returns at 153 lbs to face Emmanuel Sita, who hit the mark at 155 lbs. Both men bring relentless pace and hunger for a defining win.
- Flyweight Collision: Lihle Ngamntwini (123 lbs) meets Tebatso Molele (125 lbs) in a clash that could shape the future of the flyweight division.
- Catchweight War: Godfrey Mkhwanazi (141 lbs) takes on Roevan De Beer (140 lbs) in a battle of youthful ambition versus seasoned experience.
- Flyweight Rising Star: Nathanial Komana (126 lbs) defends his momentum against Godknows Ndlovu (130 lbs*), whose grit makes him one of the toughest challenges in the division.
