

ZONDI & MANYAMALA ADVANCE AS GRAND PRIX MOVES TO CAPE TOWN

EFC 130 OFFICIAL RESULTS & HIGHLIGHTS

4 December 2025



Johannesburg, South Africa – EFC 130 closed out the year with a high-intensity card that delivered finishes, drama and major implications for 2026.

In the flyweight Grand Prix, Ntando Zondi earned a unanimous decision over Nathaniel Komana after three competitive rounds. The co-main event produced one of the wildest opening rounds of the year, with Tumelo Manyamala stopping Lihle Ngamntwini via TKO after both men were swinging for the fences. Fans will now look ahead to Manyamala and Zondi's appearances at the KNOX Legacy Series in Cape Town.

Peace Nguphane and Armando De Crescenzo delivered the fight of the night in a thrilling three-round battle, with Nguphane taking a unanimous decision. Conrad Seabi and Zhane Tannous met in a fast-paced contest filled with mutual respect, ending with Tannous securing a first-round submission. Bryn Gwavava stayed unbeaten with a second-round rear-naked choke against Eduardo Barros in another high-energy matchup.

The prelims featured strong performances throughout the card, with standout finishes from Bradley Swanepoel, Brandon Santos, Mpho Hloka, Liam Schultz and Lucky Bosco, while Mlungisi Mbizane earned a clear decision victory. Adei Volker claimed his first professional win via disqualification after an illegal strike.

Performance bonuses were awarded to Tumelo Manyamala, Mlungisi Mbizane, Bryn Gwavava and Brandon Santos.
