

# EFC 132: ONE WEEK TO GO AS MAIN CARD TAKES FOCUS AHEAD OF FIGHT NIGHT

02 April 2026



**Johannesburg, South Africa** — With just one week remaining, EFC 132 is entering its final phase as the latest fight card is confirmed ahead of fight night in Johannesburg.

Headlining the card is a heavyweight championship clash between DRC’s Matunga “HHH” Djikasa and Senegal’s Adama Diop.

Djikasa returns as champion with a composed, range-based striking approach, while Diop enters undefeated in EFC, bringing relentless pressure and a wrestling-heavy style into the matchup.

In the co-main feature, JT Botha faces Mzwandile Hlongwa in a middleweight contest shaped by history and striking pedigree.

At bantamweight, former champion Gift Walker returns against Angola’s Eduardo Barros in a matchup built on experience and control.

Zhane Tannous meets Siyakudumisa Nomvemve at catchweight in a high stakes contest with title implications across multiple divisions.

Also on the main card, Jaco du Plessis takes on Christopher Moly at welterweight, as an established contender meets a dangerous debutant.

Across the rest of the card, a series of matchups bring a mix of prospects, returning athletes, and stylistic clashes.

Mpho Hloka faces Mlungisi Mbizane at bantamweight, a contest between two rising fighters with contrasting approaches.

Adei Volker meets Wallace Okosso at middleweight in a classic grappler versus striker matchup.

Kelvin Smit takes on Mfanufuthi Ngobese at flyweight, where experience meets power and athleticism.

Lucky Magekha faces Johannes Rudolph at featherweight, a matchup shaped by pressure against a more measured grappling approach.

Rian Dunn meets Mika Ngomane at bantamweight, with both fighters looking to re-establish momentum.

Thapelo Seabi faces Story Mpia Embombe at flyweight, bringing structure against unpredictability.

The opening bout sees Obakeng Mahura take on Zambia's Tryford Mwanga, as two developing prospects meet to start the night.

With the full lineup now confirmed and fight week approaching, EFC 132 is set to deliver a complete night of fights leading into a heavyweight championship main event.

EFC 132 takes place April 9 in Johannesburg and is presented by World Sports Betting.
