EFC 122 has undergone a late change to its fight card, as the highly anticipated lightweight clash between Cole Henning and Glody Kanzeko has been officially pulled following Henning's withdrawal due to illness.

Henning was forced out of the bout after a recent battle with a staph infection that required antibiotics, followed by a bout of the flu that left him medically unfit to compete. The timing of the withdrawal left the EFC with minimal opportunity to find a suitable replacement.

Glody Kanzeko, known for his relentless pressure and elite athleticism, was left without an opponent, as stepping in on short notice against a force like Kanzeko proved to be too daunting for available athletes.

EFC officials explored replacement options but ultimately found no athlete willing—or ready—to face a challenge of Kanzeko's caliber on such short notice. The Zambian standout's reputation as a dangerous and well-rounded threat in the lightweight division continues to grow, and it's clear that entering the Hexagon against him requires a full camp, not a few rushed days of prep.

EFC wishes Cole Henning a full and speedy recovery, and looks forward to welcoming him back to the Hexagon as soon as he's ready to compete again.

Fans can expect to see Kanzeko return to action soon as the EFC works on rescheduling his next appearance. EFC 122 will proceed with a stacked card, and the organization looks forward to delivering another explosive night of combat action.
