AFRICA DOMINATES BRAZIL IN HISTORIC TRIPLE TITLE NIGHT

EFC 123 Official Results



Johannesburg, South Africa – In a stunning display of continental pride and world-class martial arts, EFC 123: Africa’s Best vs Brazil concluded with a clean sweep for the South African athletes, who emerged victorious in all matchups against their Brazilian counterparts. Hosted at the World Sports Betting Arena in Johannesburg, the event featured a stacked 12-fight card, including three EFC title fights—all of which saw African champions rise to the occasion.
